## Private Occupational Health providers for vaccinations and proof of immunisation

If you are missing evidence of vaccinations or have not received all of the required vaccinations to begin work in a clinical setting, you will need to arrange to obtain these. Unfortunately, this is not something that Trust occupational health is able to support at this time.

Some vaccinations may be available from your GP, and it is always worth checking first. For those vaccinations that cannot be provided by your GP, there are a range of options you can use to obtain these vaccines privately. There are also services you can use for blood tests to provide evidence of vaccinations that you have already had.

We recommend that you do your own research and online searches for providers local to you and to compare prices. We do not endorse any providers, but the list below can provide you with a starting point.

<u>LloydsPharmacy Online Doctor UK</u>, which provides hepatitis B vaccinations, boosters, immunity tests and free advice, as well as a vaccination against diphtheria, tetanus and polio for people whose work puts them at risk of cuts or wounds that could get contaminated.

<u>Superdrug Health Clinic</u>, which offers a range of occupational health vaccines and screening tests, including flu, hepatitis A, hepatitis A and B, hepatitis B, and polio, diphtheria and tetanus vaccines, as well as BCG scar checking service and hepatitis B immunity test.

<u>London Travel Clinic</u>, which provides occupational health vaccinations for healthcare workers and other professionals who may be exposed to infectious diseases, such as hepatitis B, tuberculosis (BCG), meningitis ACWY, rabies, and yellow fever.

<u>CityDoc</u>, which offers occupational health services for individuals and businesses, including vaccinations for hepatitis A, hepatitis B, influenza, MMR (measles, mumps and rubella), polio, diphtheria and tetanus, typhoid, varicella (chickenpox), and yellow fever, as well as blood tests for hepatitis B immunity and tuberculosis screening.

The Fleet Street Clinic, which provides occupational health vaccinations and testing for a variety of sectors and industries, such as healthcare, education, media, travel, construction, and hospitality. Some of the vaccines they offer are hepatitis A, hepatitis B, influenza, MMR, polio, diphtheria and tetanus, rabies, typhoid, varicella, and yellow fever. They also offer blood tests for hepatitis B immunity and tuberculosis screening.

<u>Chiswick Medical Centre</u>, which is a private medical centre that offers a range of services for adults and children, including occupational health vaccinations. You can book an appointment with one of their consultants and get vaccinated against hepatitis B or diphtheria, tetanus, and polio.
